# Accomplishments

## Goal 1: Enhance and maintain a sustainable clinical research network

### **Building collaborations**

- LaRed senior leadership met the Health Secretary of the state of Chiapas to promote future collaborations and share LaRed's research capabilities.
- Minister of Health, Mexico, Commissioner, CCINSHAE, Director, National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases and senior LaRed leadership met and reinforced their commitment to continue the collaboration between NIH, NIAID and the Mexican Ministry of Health through LaRed.
- Launched LaRed's website across the network.

# Organizational Management

- Appointment of a Network Director to provide overall network oversight, promote engagement and enhance communication between LaRed governing committees.
- Appointment of a LaRed Coordinating Center (LaRed-CC) Manager to oversee clinical research operations.
- The LaRed-CC appointed two Clinical Operations Specialists to support Pls with protocol development and manuscript writing & an Admin Assistant to assist with office management
- The LaRed-CC has been relocated to its own office space
- LaRed Site Staff has been restructured based on current needs

- INSIGHT FLU-IVIG- Ongoing discussions with University of Minnesota to amend protocol to study flu-B
- Febrile study Protocol being developed for review by SSC
- SPRINT-SARI Protocol amendment 3 submitted to IRB for approval
